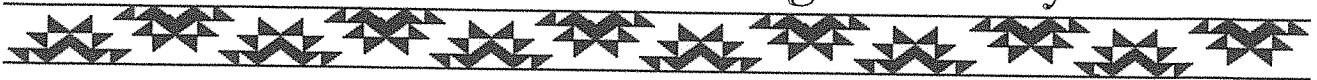

ELDER EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE POLICY

Purpose

The Elder Emergency Assistance Policy provides elder tribal member homeowners the opportunity to receive health and safety improvements, as necessary. It is the intent of this program to ensure that elder tribal members have the ability to remain in their homes.

Eligibility

- Applicant must have ownership interest in a home within the service area, live in the home as their primary residence, and be eligible according to NAHASDA guidelines;
- Among the eligible applicants, grantees shall be selected on a first come first serve basis depending upon availability of funds and may receive assistance up to the maximum assistance as defined in Section III: Assistance, below; and
- Addendum “E” Selection rating.

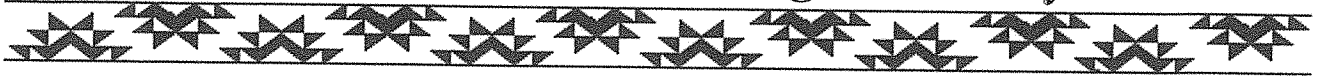
Assistance

- YIHA provides a limited health and safety assistance. Before a unit is selected, the YIHA staff will inspect the home for the condition of the home, and counsel the elder tribal member regarding the options for assistance through YIHA programs. The cost for any assistance under this program shall not exceed \$4,999.99 every five years.
- In cases of extreme hardship, the Executive Director has, at their discretion, the ability to exceed the maximum assistance cap with notification to the board.

Participant Agreement

If it is determined that the current unit is unsafe, the elder tribal member must agree to have the old unit replaced.
